Value of the award:

- USD\$1000 towards travel costs and associated expenses to attend the 2022 Asian Biophysics Association / Asia-Pacific Protein Association / Taiwan Biophysics Association joint meeting in Tainan, Taiwan between June 22-26.
- Complimentary conference registration.
- Named oral presentation slot.

Who can apply:

- Applicants should be within 5 years since receipt of the PhD in 2022 (awarded on or after January 1, 2017) or enrolled in a PhD at an institution in an APPA country.

Application process:

- Two-page CV summary, with specified criteria (refer to website), as a PDF file.
- A 250-word abstract.
- Letter of recommendation.

Closing date:

March 4, 2022
